We would like to remind everyone to make sure you keep sick children <u>home</u> if they have a <u>fever</u>, been <u>vomiting</u> or have <u>diarrhea</u> in the last 24 hours. A child must be <u>fever free (without fever medicine)</u>, vomit & diarrhea free for 24 hours, before <u>returning to school</u>. With everyone's help, we should be able to limit spreading illnesses as much as possible.
