### **Assurance Statement of Compliance with the purposes of Title IX Education Act**

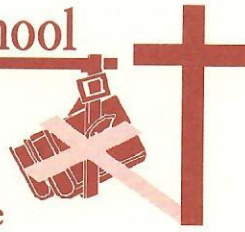

- Keep their phones, tablets, iPads, laptops... with you at night.

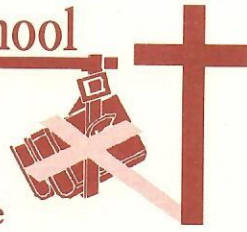
Feel free to share with me your concerns so we can support our kids effectively.

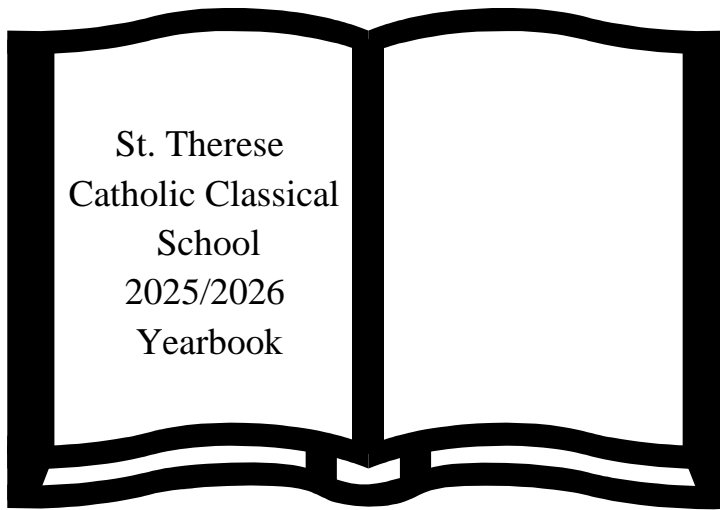
Aquí tiene algunas cosas que puede hacer para limitar su tiempo y actividades en línea:
